OFFER DESCRIPTION

The Laboratory of Instrumentation and Experimental Particle Physics (LIP) is opening an international selection tender for 1 vacancy for the post of Assistant Researcher. This competition is open under the Agreement Programme celebrated with the Foundation for Science and Technology (Associate Laboratory funding).

The candidate will be hired under non-fixed term work contract, pursuant to the dispositions of articles 6(1) b)) and 7 of the Decree-Law no. 57/2016 of 29th August, updated by the Law nº 57/2017, of 19th July and to the Labour Code, under its current reading.

The candidate is hired to perform data analysis of dark matter search experiments and research of the neutrino nature. LIP is presently carrying out data analysis in these two research topics through several projects.

The candidates should be PhD holders in physics, physics engineering or a related field, with more than 5 years of post-doctoral research, with relevant experience in the scientific area of application and demonstrating scientific independence for the last 3 years.

Applicable Legislation

- Decree-Law no. 57/2016 of 29th August, which approved the doctorate hiring regime destined to stimulate scientific and technological employment for all knowledge areas (RJEC), updated by the Law nº 57/2017, of 19th July.
- Labour Code approved by Law no. 7/2009 of 12th February, under its current reading
- Regulatory Decree nº 11-A/2017, of 29th December.

Application formalization shall be made by sending:

- a) Motivation letter;
- b) Detailed Curriculum Vitae;
- c) One electronic copy of a document that compiles up to five (5) publications selected by the candidate as being the most representative of the candidate's work in terms of his/her contributions to the development and evolution of the scientific area of the competition, clearly stating the date and place (publisher) for each publication. For each selected publication, the document must state the reason why said publication was chosen by the candidate bearing in mind its contribution to the scientific area of the competition;
- d) Transcripts of diplomas or degrees with final grades and other documents demonstrating the candidate's suitability for the required profile. Recognition of foreign diploma should also be delivered, if applicable;
- e) Contacts of two references who have supervised or worked directly with the candidate.
- f) Other documentation relevant for the evaluation of qualifications in a related scientific area.

Candidates shall submit their application files and supporting documentation, in a digital form, in PDF format, via email to concursos@coimbra.lip.pt.

All candidates who formalize their applications in an improper way or fail to prove the requirements imposed by this tender are excluded from admission. In case of doubt, the panel is entitled to request any candidate to present further documentation supporting his/her statements.

False statements provided by the candidates shall be punished by law.

Both admitted and excluded candidate list and final classification list shall be sent by email to all candidates with delivery receipt.

Preliminary Hearing and Final Decision Deadline: Pursuant to article 121 of the Administrative Procedure Code, after notified, all candidates have 10 working days to respond. Panel's final decisions are pronounced within a period of 90 days, from application deadline.

This tender is exclusively destined to fill the vacancy and can be terminated at any time until approval of final candidate list, expiring with the respective occupation of said vacancy.

Non-discrimination and equal access policy: LIP actively promotes a nondiscrimination and equal access policy, wherefore no candidate can be privileged, benefited, impaired or deprived of any rights whatsoever, or be exempt of any duties based on their ancestry, age, sex, sexual preference, marital status, family and economic conditions, instruction, origin or social conditions, genetic heritage, reduced work capacity, disability, chronic illness, nationality, ethnic origin or race, origin territory, language, religion, political or ideological convictions and union membership.

The panel has approved this announcement in meeting held on 18th January 2022.

Pursuant to Decree-Law no. 29/2001 of 3 February, disabled candidates shall be preferred in a situation of equal classification, and said preference supersedes any legal preferences. Candidates must declare, on their honor, their respective disability degree, type of disability and communication/expression means to be used during selection period on their application form, under the regulations above.

Benefits

Gross monthly remuneration (before tax and social security contributions) is 3.230,21 Euros/month, as defined by article 15 (1) of the Law nº 57/2016 of 29th August updated by the law 57/2017, of 19th July, corresponding to the position of Assistant Researcher on an exclusive basis, according to the categories foreseen in the Research Career's Remuneration Table (Index 195).

Eligibility criteria

Any national, foreign or stateless candidates who hold a doctorate degree in Physics or related scientific area and a scientific and professional curriculum whose profile is suited for the activity to be performed can submit their applications.

In the event of the degree was awarded by a foreign higher education institution, the degree must comply with the provisions of the Decree-Law nº. 66/2018, of 16 August (<https://www.dges.gov.pt/en/pagina/degree-and-diploma-recognition?plid=1536>). The selected candidate must provide the recognition of the degree when signing the contract.

Evaluation criteria are the following:

Evaluation of the CV of the candidates, according to the above criteria and scientific merit of the presented proposal in the context of the LIP strategic plan.

Each member of the panel will value the criteria for each candidate, taking into account the requirements of the duties to be performed, the adequacy of previous experience, his/her relationship to the relevant areas and sub-areas. The selection method will consider the candidate's curriculum vitae (50%), the adequacy of previous experience to the duties to be performed (40%) and the motivation letter (10%)

Selection process

The tender selection panel shall be formed by:

- Mário Pimenta, Full Professor IST/ LIP President
- Isabel Lopes, Full Professor – Coimbra University/LIP Board of Directors
- José Maneira, Assistant Researcher at LIP

Selection is to be made based on the evaluation of the scientific and curricular career of the candidates whose application is considered admissible.

Scientific and curricular career evaluation focuses on the last five years taking into account the relevance and quality of:

- a) scientific and technological production in the last five years, deemed most relevant by the candidate;
- b) knowledge extension and dissemination activities developed in the last five years, namely under the scope of the promotion of culture and scientific practices, deemed most relevant by the candidate;
- c) activities of management of science, technology and innovation programmes, or experience in observing and monitoring the scientific and technological, or higher education system in Portugal or abroad.

The five-year period mentioned above can be extended by the panel, if requested by the candidate, whenever the suspension of scientific activities is reasoned by socially protected grounds, like paternity/maternity leave, long-term serious illness, and other legal situations of unavailability to work.

The panel shall deliberate by means of roll-call vote justified under adopted and disclosed selection criteria, with no abstentions allowed.

Minutes of panel meetings shall be registered and include a summary of all occurrences of said meeting, as well as of all votes casted by the members and respective reasoning and will be provided to candidates whenever required.

After selection criteria application, the panel shall prepare an ordered list of the approved candidates with corresponding classifications.

The panel's final decision shall be validated by the head of the institution, who is also responsible for the hiring.


